The Geauga County Engineer will continue to be open and dedicated to serving the public through Governor Mike DeWine's latest "Stay Safe" order.

Please read below pertinent information regarding safe practices implemented and/or upheld by the Engineer for employees and the public:

- Face coverings to be worn by employees at all times

- Increased space between work stations
- Temperature reporting for employees
- Some personnel will continue to operate remotely

However, the Engineer will continue to serve the public.
