CONSTRUCTION UPDATE
May 19, 2023

Gauga County Engineer, Joe Cattell, PE, PS, has announced the start/continuance of construction on the following projects in Gauga County.

- **Hambden Township, Williams Road:** Shoulder Widening and Asphalt Resurfacing will begin on/about May 5th for approximately 21 days. Traffic will be maintained, expect delays.
- **Burton Township, Rider Road:** Asphalt Resurfacing will begin on/about May 15th for approximately 7 days. Traffic will be maintained, expect delays.
- **Parkman Township, Old State Road and Farmington Road:** Asphalt Resurfacing will begin on/about May 15th for approximately 21 days. Traffic will be maintained, expect delays.
- **Montville Township, Morgan Road and Leggett Road:** Asphalt Resurfacing will begin on/about May 22th for approximately 28 days. Traffic will be maintained, expect delays.
- **Claridon and Hambden Townships, Taylor Wells Road:** Shoulder Widening and Asphalt Resurfacing will begin on/about May 30th for approximately 42 days. Traffic will be maintained, expect delays.
- **Auburn Township, Washington Street:** Bridge Replacement between Bainbridge Road and Munn Road will begin on/about May 30th for approximately 30 days. The road will be closed to all traffic. Detour will be posted.
